Daily work. Be ready to answer the reading questions. I'll quiz sometimes.

Collected homework. Homeworks run in two rounds: first, I give feedback (but no grade); on a revision, I assign a grade (but no further feedback). Each problem gets 10, 6, or 0 points. Homeworks are group work: you can work with anyone in the class, or on your own if you prefer, and hand in one copy for the group.

All homeworks are due at the beginning of class on the due date.

Projects. The bulk of the work and of the grade in this course. Each of you must implement each project yourself, but they are collaborative (you can talk to other people about them).

Each will have two checkpoints that I'll describe in detail elsewhere, plus a final handin. Design work is due at the start of class on its due date, and prep work and final versions are due at 8pm on their respective due dates unless I say otherwise.

Exams. The midterm exam is take-home and the final is mixed TH and in-person; both will be non-collaborative: you are not permitted to discuss the exam with *anyone at all* other than me. The final exam will be Mon 4 Dec at 3–5:30pm.
