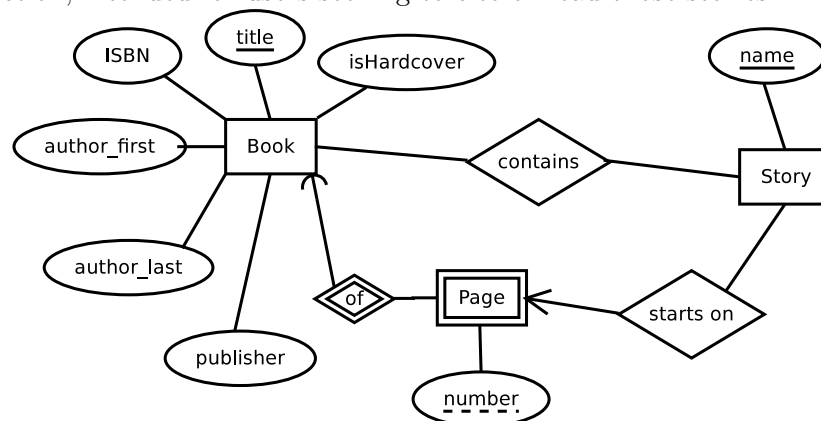
Problem 3.1
